I am sending my last On Call as your SCEOT President! It has been a privilege and an honour to represent you and meet many of you over the last 4 years. Although I am retiring, I will stand with you in solidarity while Unions bargain for our students, our members and to protect our PUBLIC education system. Remember, OTs are a vital part of the education system. You matter!

The Board will be sending out email notices to members who **have not** completed their Offence Declaration on the Payroll portal and/or those who have incomplete mandatory training. Failure to complete this may result in termination.

Job postings are beginning to be sent out to ATE. The Board will continue to post as jobs become available now and again sometime in August. No specific dates are known.

Payroll will send out ROEs (Record of Employment) automatically to Service Canada sometime after the last day of school. Please direct all EI questions to Service Canada as the Local cannot answer any questions.

ETFO Central bargaining is underway as of June 15. The first meetings focused on setting the ground rules for bargaining, and next steps will include determining what issues will be bargained centrally. This is an important round of bargaining for member rights, working conditions, and public education.
